“Studio di pittura” invites Klemens Schillinger for a site specific installation, in which the Austrian designer will reside in the days of Milano Design Week.

An hybrid installation between work-space and guest-room, featuring a range of utilitarian pieces tailored to the studio and set in visual dialogue with photographs by Louis De Belle.

The exhibition takes place in two venues: Pasticceria G. Cova, in viale Monza 91 and the top-floor private space Studio di pittura, in via Popoli Uniti, 1.

For this occasion, Klemens Schillinger imagined a pilot room, hence the title “musterzimmer”, in which he presents his latest collection of everyday products, also suggested by a previous residency in the space.

A key piece is a broom with a hook, indispensable to the designer-in-residence who must tidy up before visitors arrive. Among the many products is a paper basket designed to fit the octagonal floor plan of the studio where the installation will be hosted.

An integral part of the installation are photographs by Louis De Belle, chosen from shots of a survey of the neighborhood north of Piazza Loreto.

In Pasticceria G. Cova & C., a photo of a one-piece plastic chair with a Vienna straw insert (used by street artisans to promote themselves) dialogues ironically with the Austrian designer's XD Chair. In the SdP environment, the large “Governo Provvisorio” photo depicts an iconic detail of a housing building in the square of the same name dedicated to the institution that governed Milan during the Five Days, leading to its liberation from the Austrians.

“Studio di pittura” is a private octagonal space with exquisite natural light and is available to artists visiting Milan.

We invite overseas artists and designers to temporarily occupy the space with site-specific installations, where guests are welcome to approach the artist and their work in a convivial atmosphere.

SdP is a decompression room, a space to share and experiment thereby opening up synergies and possibilities to collaborate.

“Studio di pittura” is a project of Gianmaria Sforza, the idea of inviting Klemens Schillinger (<https://www.klemensschillinger.com>) is by Louis De Belle (<http://www.louisdebelle.com>), who signs all the images in the exhibition and of the installation, and Luca Quagliato (Nepente Film) (<https://vimeo.com/lucaquagliato>) was involved for the video production.

An important part of the operation is the synergy with Pasticceria G. Cova & C. on Viale Monza, 91, which will remain open until midnight-normally it closes at 7 p.m.-and will host Friday night's party. A corner of the pastry shop will be set up with some pieces by Klemens Schillinger and never-before-seen prints by Louis De Belle.

The installation will be viewable by invitation Wednesday through Friday (12-5 p.m.) and open to the public by reservation Saturday (2-8 p.m.). For follow-up, photos by Louis De Belle and video by Luca Quagliato will be produced for publication.
